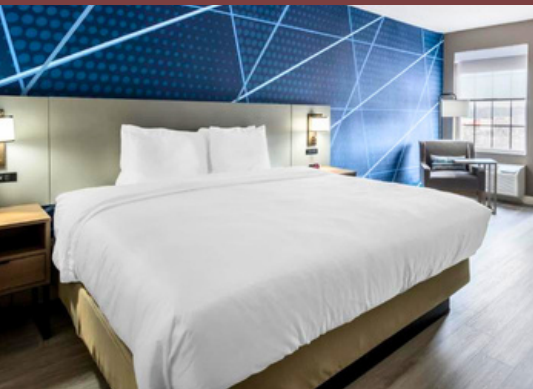

Pork Shoulder. Chopped. Course-Chopped. Sliced.

Sandwich *barbecue piled on a bun with red slaw & a drizzle of dip*

Plate *barbecue, red slaw, fries, & either a roll or hushpuppies*

Tray *smaller portion with equal parts barbecue & red slaw*

Sauce *"dip" - a thin, tangy mix of ketchup, vinegar, salt, pepper & a touch of sugar*

Slaw *red slaw—finely chopped cabbage mixed with barbecue dip*

Hushpuppies

deep-fried bits of cornmeal batter - crispy on the outside & soft on the inside; served as a side

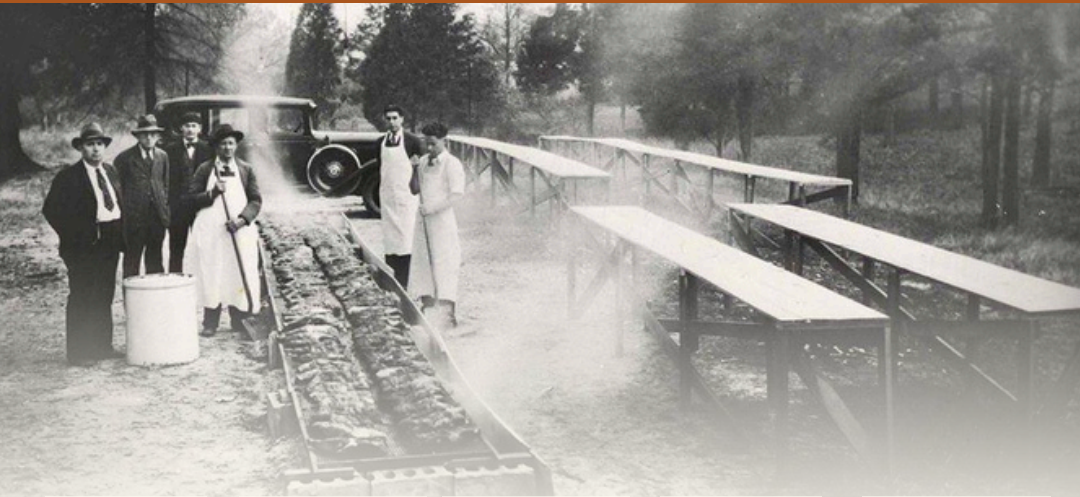

1919

Sid Weaver moves his barbecue operation to Uptown Lexington at the corner of West Center/Greensboro streets.

1920s

Jesse Swicegood & Will Johnson establish barbecue as a local industry, with their pits located near the old Davidson County Courthouse.

1950s

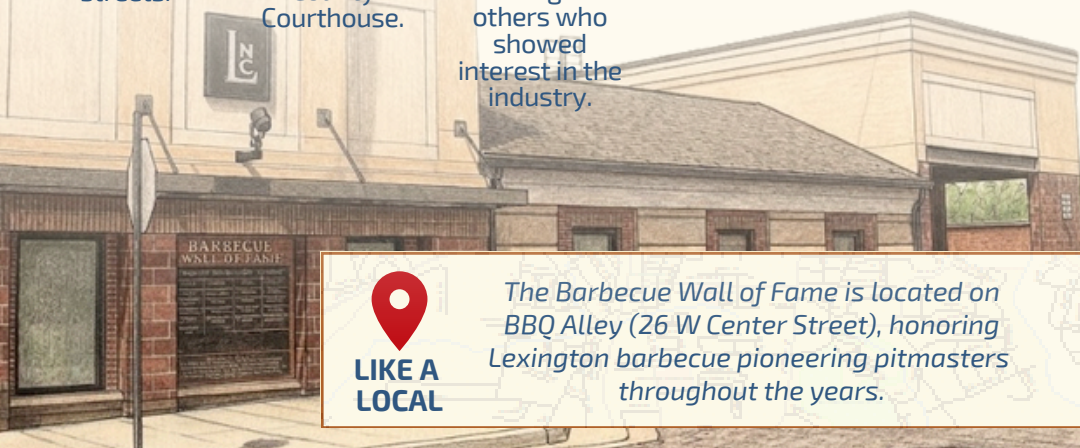
More people learned the trade & opened barbecue restaurants. Warner Stamey was one of the top barbecue entrepreneurs who shared knowledge with others who showed interest in the industry.

1984

Lexington hosts the first Lexington Barbecue Festival.

The Barbecue Wall of Fame is located on BBQ Alley (26 W Center Street), honoring Lexington barbecue pioneering pitmasters throughout the years.

BARBECUE FESTIVAL



The first Barbecue Festival launched on October 27, 1984, with 30,000 attendees and 3,000 pounds of barbecue. Strong local support dramatically expanded the festival four decades, now drawing crowds as large as 200,000. The festival has earned national recognition by Travel + Leisure, the Southeast Tourism Society, the Library of Congress, and USA Today as one of America's top food festivals.

Held annually in October, the festival anchors a month-long celebration officially declared "Barbecue Month" in Lexington and Davidson County. On festival day, nine blocks of Uptown Lexington's Main Street close to traffic as hundreds of exhibitors, artists, and craftsmen fill the streets alongside multiple entertainment stages, and barbecue tents all serving one type of 'cue - *Lexington style*.

The festival continues to celebrate Lexington-style barbecue and welcome fans from around the world.

The Uptown District is centrally known for its historic architecture, friendly faces, and welcoming hospitality. Centered along Main Street, Uptown features locally owned shops, antiques stores, art galleries, and cozy cafes housed in beautifully preserved historic buildings. Visitors explore landmarks, public art, seasonal festivals, and community events throughout the year.

Uptown Lexington has the area's largest collection of small businesses, creating a lively mix of locally owned shops, restaurants, and unique finds.



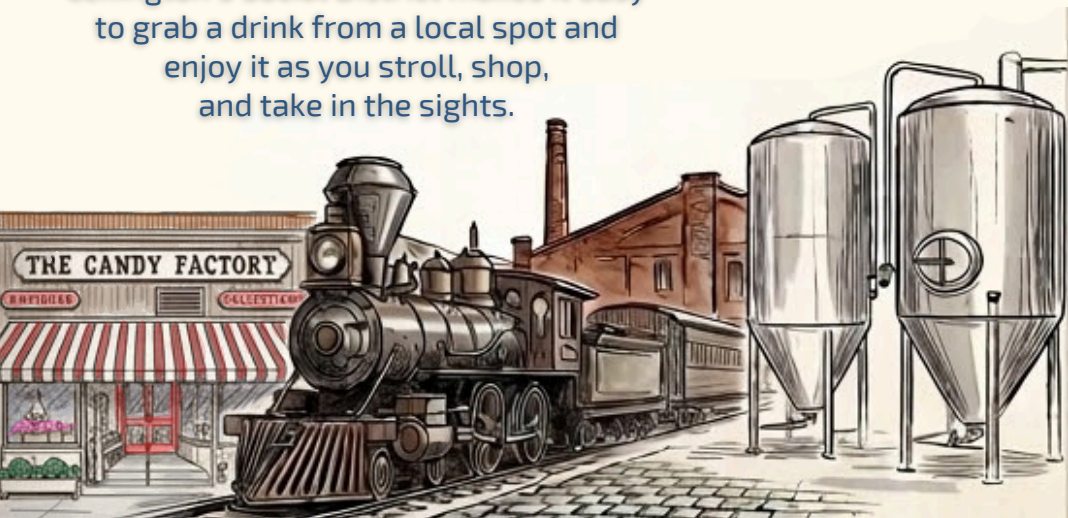
DEPOT DISTRICT



Old Meets New

The Depot District - a revitalized area located just outside Uptown Lexington - blends the city's industrial past with modern attractions. Once dominated by furniture manufacturing and warehouses, the district is evolving into a mixed-use destination that continues to grow. A key feature of the district is Breeden Amphitheater, hosting concerts, festivals, and community events throughout the year. Local businesses, such as Bull City Ciderworks and Goose and the Monkey Brewhouse, transformed former industrial buildings into lively gathering spaces, anchoring the district as a hub.

Lexington's Social District makes it easy to grab a drink from a local spot and enjoy it as you stroll, shop, and take in the sights.

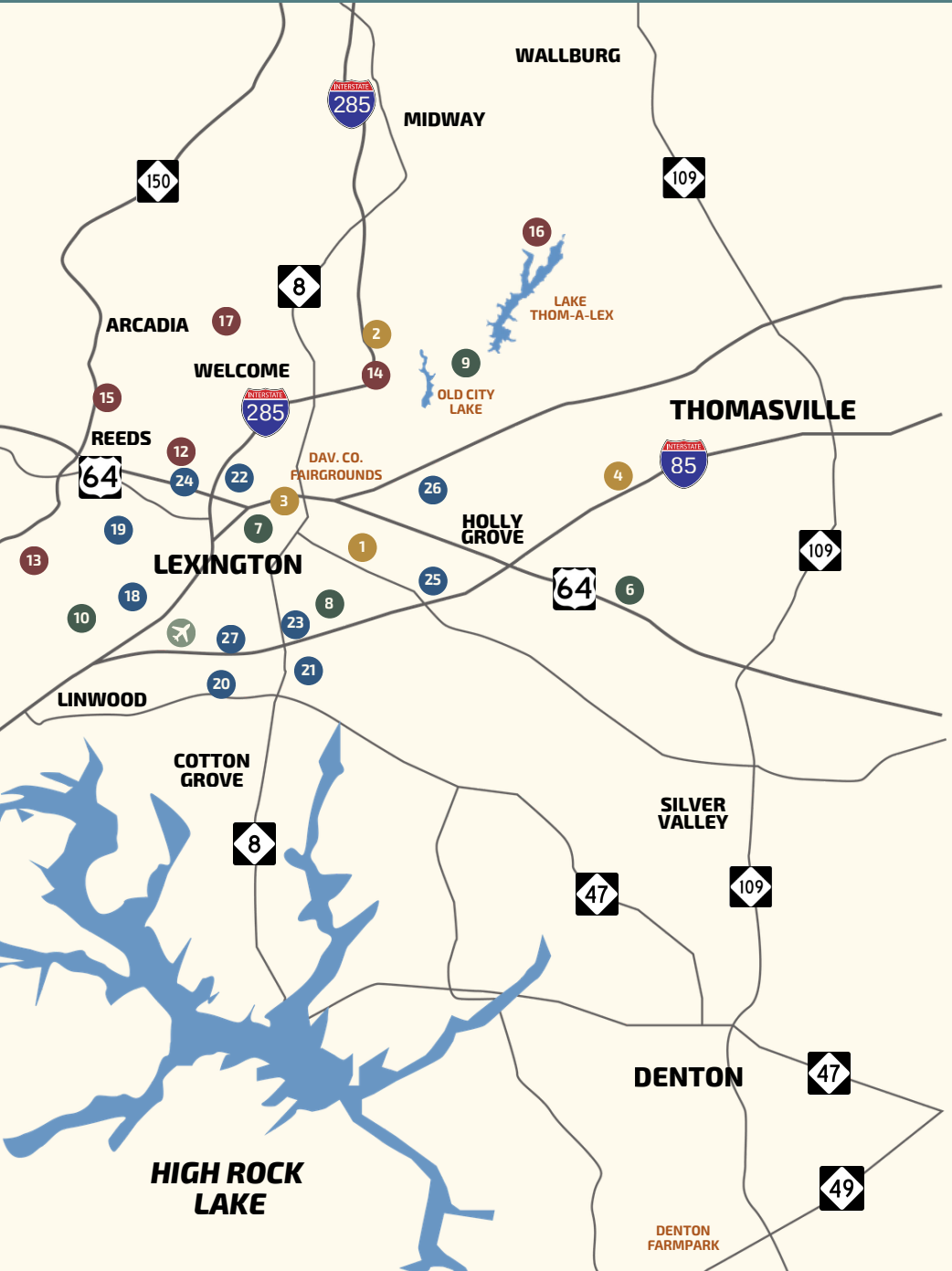

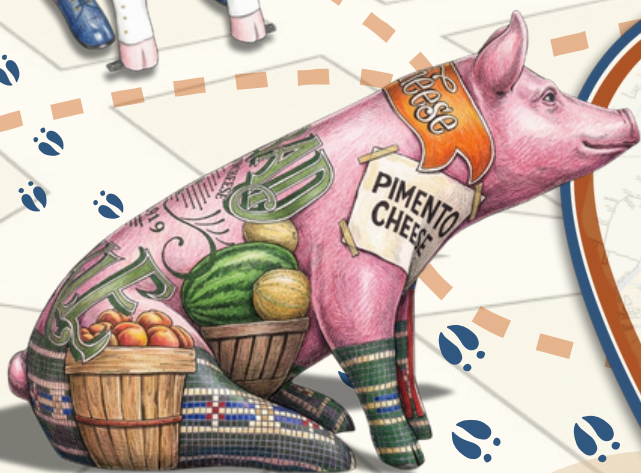
